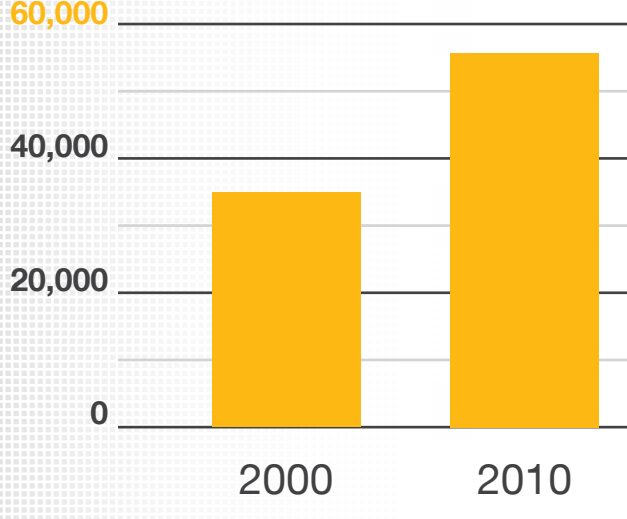

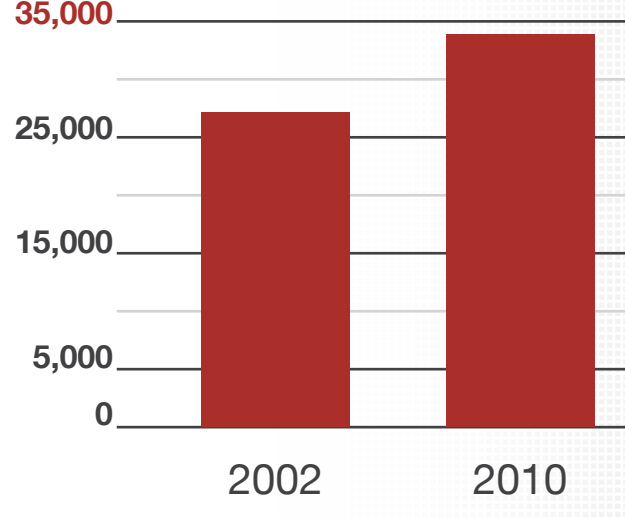

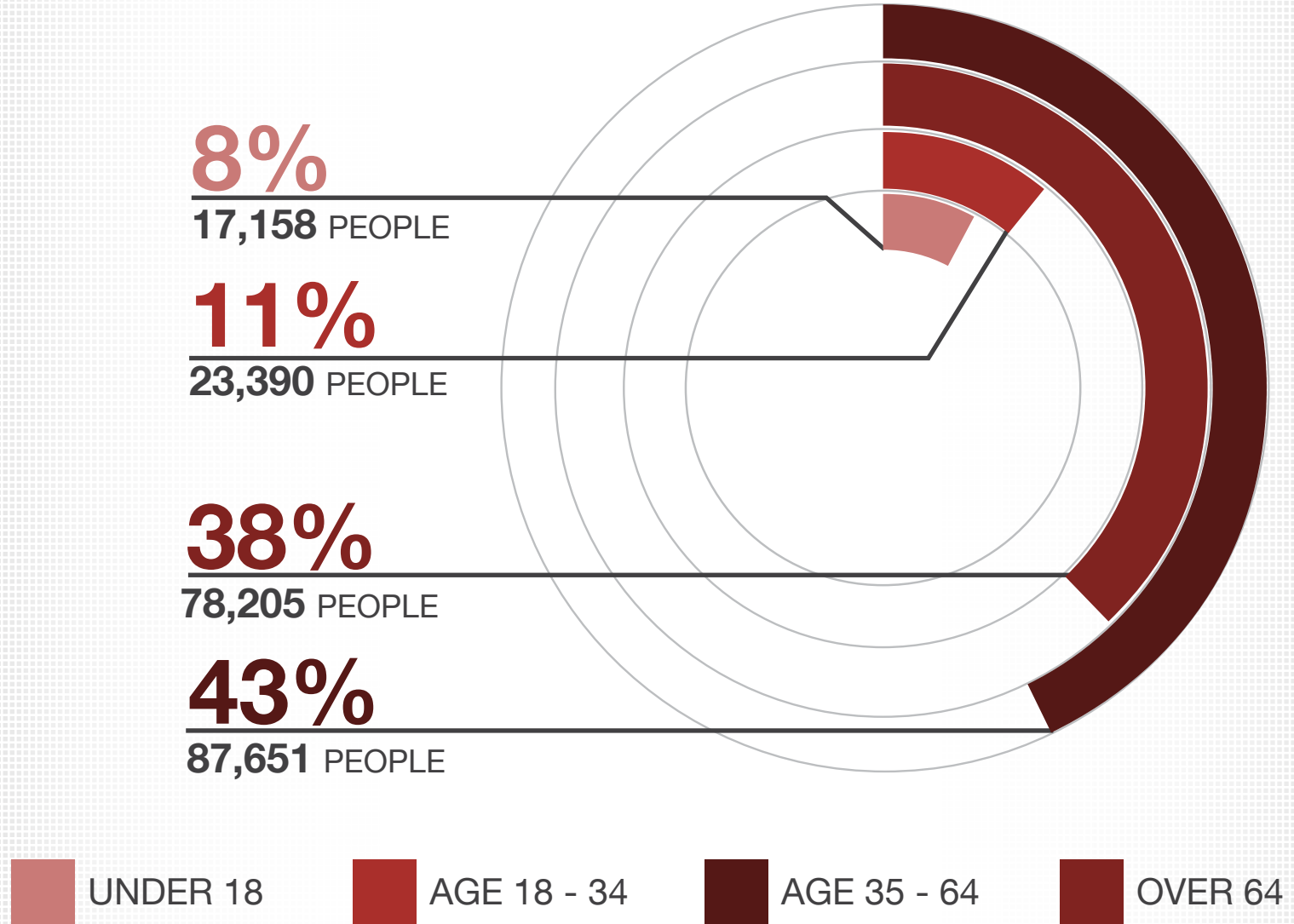
### MAINERS RECEIVING SSDI BENEFITS
